Both Doctors are on the faculty of the Medical College of Georgia, School of Dentistry as associate clinical instructors for dental students externing in Atlanta. They have also volunteered time for over 20 years to delivering dental care to the needy at the Massell Dental Clinic (an agency of United Way). In addition, both have completed a one-year residency program in the restoration of Dental Implants and Esthetic Dentistry.

PRIORITIES

A thorough oral cancer screening and dental examination, medical history, x-rays, and sometimes plaster models of your teeth are essential to a proper diagnosis. Emergency problems are cared for first. Then, a detailed treatment recommendation is given as a guideline to attain optimum dental health now and for years to come. We will also show you how to effectively clean your mouth to prevent disease.

SCHEDULING APPOINTMENTS

We're aware of how difficult it is to include dental appointments into a busy schedule. That's why we make every effort to see you at your scheduled time. Your prompt arrival will help make this possible.

Patients are seen by appointment only, Monday through Friday, between 8:10 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. As a service to you, we make every effort to confirm your appointment; however, it is your obligation to keep your scheduled time. We pre-appoint our patients for their regular cleanings and examinations, usually every three to six months, according to need.

RELAXED VISIT

Our office attempts to make your visit as relaxed as possible. We understand how uneasy some patients may feel. Modern treatment techniques can be used with available stereo headphones, nitrous oxide gas, pharmacological agents and a local anesthetic to help ensure that you are relaxed during your visit.

VIDEO EDUCATION

Our office has a video education system that helps give you more information about any dental problems you may have and explains ways we can solve these problems. We have intra oral cameras for visual examination of your mouth.

DENTAL INSURANCE

We'll be happy to assist you with your dental insurance by preparing the claims for submission to your carrier. It is very important that on your first visit you bring your insurance card and give us the correct information regarding your coverage. As a courtesy to you, we do allow direct payment from your insurance company to us for the services that are covered. All we ask is that you pay your portion on each visit.

We will help you calculate your insurance benefits, but please understand that these are just estimates. We can also file written pre-treatment estimates for larger cases.

Please remember that your dental insurance is a contract between you and the carrier. The ultimate responsibility for payment rest with you.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

Our dental fees are comparable to other competent dentists in our vicinity. You'll receive a written estimate prior to commencement of any extensive treatment. If you are in doubt, do not hesitate to ask about our fees prior to treatment.

We ask that you pay for initial visits and amounts not covered by insurance at the time of your appointment. Patients paying in advance and filing their own insurance receive a discount on their fees.

We accept cash, checks, MasterCard, Visa, American Express, and Discover. We also provide financial arrangements for extensive treatment. Using Unicorn® or CareCredit® you may qualify for interest free payments up to 12 months. Longer payment plans up to 5 years are available with interest. Please call our office for more details. Returned checks and balances older than 30 days may be subject to additional collection fees and interest charges

Parking: We are located in Peachtree Center, International Tower, near the Hard Rock Cafe and the old Macy's. Park at the **International parking deck on International Blvd.**, next to Dailey's restaurant, and come to the fifth floor of the parking deck, where there is a bridge that goes directly into the International Tower. Our office is ahead on the right as you come in. You, of course, can park at other nearby parking areas.

If you come on MARTA, the train stops at the **Peachtree Center Station**. Take the **Harris Street** exit. There you can take the escalator upstairs and come into Peachtree Center, then go up the escalators in the food court or the elevators near International Blvd. in the International Tower up to the second floor, Suite 206.

Directions from the North: I-85 or I-75 south to Courtland Street exit. Turn right on International Blvd. and cross Peachtree Center Avenue. The International parking garage is on your left. Come to Level 5 if possible. Use walkway into International Tower.

Directions from the South: I-75/85 North to the International Blvd. exit. At the 2nd traffic light turn left onto International Blvd. Cross Piedmont Road and Peachtree Center Avenue. Park in the International garage on left. Come to Level 5 if possible. Use walkway into International Tower.
